After many years of work a draft IMA List of Gem Materials was posted on the IMA website at http://www.ima-mineralogy.org/docs/IMA CGM List (2016-08).pdf. From the preface:

"In the following pages of this document a comprehensive list of gem materials is presented. The list is distributed (for terms and conditions see below) via the web site of the Commission on Gem Materials of the International Mineralogical Association. The list will be updated on a regular basis.

Mineral names and formulae are from the IMA List of Minerals. Where there is a discrepancy the IMA List of Minerals will take precedence.

Caveat (IMPORTANT): inevitably there will be mistakes in a list of this type. We will be grateful to all those who will point out errors of any kind, including typos.

The List was based initially on the varietal names listed in the CIBJO "blue book" on gemstones (http://download.cibjo.org/CIBJO Gemstone Book 2011-1.pdf, officially "The Gemstone Book"). This was augmented with a list of names provided by Jim Shigley (Gemological Institute of America) from the Commission's previous foray into producing a gem glossary.

LIST OF WORLD GEM MUSEUMS

Work has begun on creating a web page with contact information and links for all world gem museums.

LIST OF CURRENT PRODUCERS

There has been some discussion on compiling a list of current producers of gem materials. It was thought that this could be done by the country representatives and would be compiled by the Chairman.

LIST OF COUNTRY REPRESENTATIVES
